

Important Dates March 15th

Tax Filing Deadline: Partnership (1065) and S-Corp (1120S) Returns

- To file on time, all documents must be provided by **February** 23rd or an extension will be filed
- **April 15th**

Due date to elect S-Corp status for existing corporations or LLCs

To file on time, all documents must be provided by March 18th,

- Tax Filing Deadline: Individual (1040), Trust & Estate (1041) and C-Corp (1120) Returns
- Last Day to Make HSA Contributions
